Item 1: Opening of the meeting

1. The first meeting of the Expanded Bureau of the ninth meeting of the Conference of the Parties will be convened from 23 to 24 June 2009 at the International Environmental House 1 (Room 3) in Geneva, Switzerland. The meeting will be opened by the President, Mr. Rachmat Witoelar, State Minister for the Environment (Indonesia) at 10 a.m. on 23 June.

Item 3: Report on the implementation of decisions adopted at the ninth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Basel Convention

3. The Expanded Bureau will be given an oral report of the status of implementation of decisions adopted by the ninth meeting of the Conference of the Parties. The Bureau will be invited to take note of the information provided and to provide guidance, as requested by the Secretariat when making the oral reports. - 4. The Secretariat will present an oral report on the status of implementation of decisions relating to technical and scientific matters which will include:
- (a) The Nairobi Declaration on the Environmentally Sound Management of Electrical and Electronic Waste;
- (b) The preparation of draft technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of mercury wastes and revised technical guidelines on used tyres.
- 5. The Secretariat will report on the status of implementation of decisions relating to legal and compliance matters, international cooperation and coordination, and ship dismantling which, among other things, will include:
 - (a) Enforcement of the Convention and combating illegal traffic;
- (b) An update on the request for observer status with the Committee on Trade and Environment of the World Trade Organization;
- (c) A report on steps taken by the Secretariat in respect of ship dismantling, including updates on the Global Programme for Sustainable Ship Recycling and the status of the International Convention for the Safe and Environmentally Sound Recycling of Ships;
- (d) A report on the status of comments received by Parties and others further to relevant decisions of the ninth meeting of the Conference of the Parties.
- 6. The Expanded Bureau will be invited to consider the financial reports for the Basel Convention Trust Fund and Technical Cooperation Trust Fund for the year 2008.
