NOTIFICATION OF NATIONAL DEFINITION OF HAZARDOUS WASTES PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 3 OF THE BASEL CONVENTION

Pursuant to Article 3 of the Basel Convention, the Republic of Bulgaria transmitted a communication to the Secretariat concerning its national definition of wastes, other than those listed in Annexes I and II of the Convention, considered or defined as hazardous under its national legislation.

By this communication, the Republic of Bulgaria informed Parties, through the Secretariat, that its national definition of hazardous wastes includes wastes listed in Annexes I, II and VIII of the Basel Convention and additionally covers some hazardous wastes specified on the list established by Commission Decision 2000/532/EC (EU-Waste List), which have no analogues in the Basel Convention.

Paragraph 3 of Article 3 of the Basel Convention states that the Secretariat shall inform all Parties of the information it has received pursuant to paragraphs 1 and 2 thereto. Accordingly, the Secretariat transmits the present Communication to Parties.

Bulgarian national definition of hazardous waste is based on Council Directive of 12 December 1991 on hazardous waste (91/689/EEC), as amended, according to which "hazardous waste" is: -waste classified as hazardous waste featuring on the list established by Commission Decision 2000/532/EC (EU-Waste List) on the basis of Annexes I and II to the directive. This waste must have one or more of the properties listed in Annex III. The list shall take into account the origin and composition of the waste and, where necessary, limit values of concentration - any other waste which is considered by a Member State to display any of the properties listed in

Annex III.

The requirements on the classification of waste as hazardous as laid down in Directive 91/689/EEC are completely transposed into the Bulgarian legislation by Ordinance No 3 on waste classification (SG 44/25.05.2004) without any other national requirements regarding the waste classification. The Bulgarian Ordinance No 3 covers only the hazardous wastes mentioned in the EU-Waste List (entries marked with an asterisk*) and does not include wastes, considered on national level to display any of the properties in Annex III.

According to the national definition Bulgaria controls the wastes, listed in the Annexes I, II and VIII of the Basel Convention and additionally some hazardous wastes, specified on the list established by Commission Decision 2000/532/EC (EU-Waste List), which have no analogues in the Basel Convention.
