
(6) Request for information on compliance

Decision: BC-11/8: Committee for Administering the Mechanism for Promoting Implementation and Compliance of the Basel Convention

Background:

By its decision BC-11/8 on the Committee for Administering the Mechanism for Promoting Implementation and Compliance of the Basel Convention, COP-11 adopted the work programme for 2014-2015 of the Committee. Several elements of that work programme are a continuation of activities already part of the Committee's work programme for 2012-2013, namely: 1) the finalization, taking into account comments received by parties and BCRCs by 31 July 2013 and including through consultations with the OEWG, of the development of draft guidance on the developments of inventories; 2) the finalization, including through consultations with the OEWG, of the development of guidance on the take back provision; and 3) the finalization, including through consultations with the OEWG, of the updating of the guide to the control system.

As requested by the Committee during its ninth meeting, the Secretariat has, in a letter dated 22 February 2013, communicated an invitation for parties, Basel Convention Regional Centres (BCRCs) and others to provide comments on a preliminary draft methodological guide for the development of inventories draft guidance on the developments of inventories, a draft revised guide to the control system, and a draft guidance on the implementation of the Basel Convention illegal traffic take back provision.
