- **Decision making process:**
- **A. Main steps:**
- Acknowledgement of receipt of equipment by Mega Store to correspondent
- Declaration to Customs and identification of the equipment in presence of the customs officers on basis of Bill of loading, invoice , transportation bill , conformity document , or use of a custom agent with which Maga store should sign a contract of services (custom fees, Maga Store to handle the documents mentioned to the custom officer)
- Collection of the material and transportation to Mega store warehouse
- Separation and Testing to determine if the material can be reused, refurbished (dismantling) , parts that can be used or not
- Storage of materials according to their final use
- Precede to reparation or refurbishment
- In all these processes, respect all measures for safety of workers, public and environment in general



B. Advantages

- 1. Existence of the Mego Store is an indicator of a first step of environmental sound management
- 2. Existence of an expertise al (administrative and technical)
- 3. Valorization of the raw-materials and precious metals
- 4. Employment creation, the increase of GDP and contribution to poverty elevation

- 6. Access to equipment at affordable prices
- 7. Incentive to access to loans and to work with financial institutions



B. Challenges

- 1. Lack of financial and technical capacities

- 5. Absence of awareness raising and sensitization programs of the public, officials and decision makers
