OBJECTIVE

To promote ESM of plastic waste in Nigeria by providing inventory data on local plastic waste generation and trade, and mapping stakeholders involved in the lifecycle of plastic management

ACTIVITIES

- Implement national inventory for the import and export of plastic wastes, and establish a mechanism or updating the inventory;
- Implement national inventory of generation of plastic waste to support ESM;
- Map stakeholders in plastics life cycle, and create platform for networking;
- Project communication;
- Coordinate, monitor, gather, and report data relevant for the project evaluation.
