OBJECTIVE

To improve capacities and capabilities of participating countries for ESM of single-use plastic and its waste, and prevent and minimize the generation and adverse impact of single-use plastic waste

ACTIVITIES

Activity 1:

- Develop an inventory for SUPs and its waste for each participating country using baseline information
- Evaluate the environmental and socio-economic impacts of major SUP products
- Produce a list of SUP types to be restricted and standards of restricted SUPs for each country

Activity 2:

- Review measures taken to reduce SUP consumption and waste and identify lessons learned and potential actions be transferred to local context
- Conduct public survey and convene a national multi-stakeholder consultation Propose policy options for SUPs and its waste at the national levels



Activity 3:

- Identify potential substitutions, collection measures and handling technologies for major SUPs and its waste
- Develop a regional strategy on production, collection, handling and sound management of SUPs and its waste
- Convene a regional multi-stakeholder consultation to review the proposed strategy
