## **ACTIVITIES**

- Test the Basel Convention plastic waste inventory toolkit in order to estimate the amounts of plastic wastes generated and to identify the main sources of plastic waste in the target countries;
- Assess the national legal and institutional frameworks as well as the capacities for prevention/minimization, control of transboundary movements (TBM) and environmentally sound management (ESM) of plastic waste in the target countries;
- Develop recommendations to adjust the national and regional legal and institutional frameworks as well as to strengthen the capacities for prevention / minimization, control of TBM and ESM of plastic waste;
- Hold a regional workshop to discuss the project outcomes, lessons learned and next steps;
- Implement a communication strategy.
